

Call for Papers: Current Topics in the Field of Economic Sociology

Session of the Economic Sociology Section of the Austrian Society for Sociology at the Sociology Conference 'The Climate of Society' at the University of Graz on 30.06-02.07.2025

Economic sociology is a dynamic research domain dedicated to the sociological analysis of economic phenomena and the interplay between economy and society. As a core area of sociology, it encompasses and expands upon specialized subfields such as the sociology of labor and industry, monetary and financial sociology, consumer sociology, as well as contributions from network, institutional, and organizational sociology.

The Economic Sociology Section of the Austrian Sociological Association (ÖGS) seeks to highlight the diversity of perspectives within the field, including critical, historically comparative, empirical, and theoretical approaches. To reflect the dynamic nature of economic sociological research, this session is designed to remain thematically, theoretically, and methodologically inclusive.

We invite submissions that present planned, near-completion, or finalized research in economic sociology. Contributions may address a wide range of topics, theories, and methods, including interdisciplinary intersections with related research areas. We particularly encourage submissions from early-career researchers, including pre-doctoral scholars.
